You forgot to water the flowers.



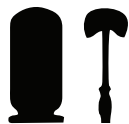

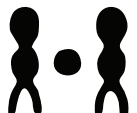
Your snail is escaping.



Humpty Dumpty's legs.



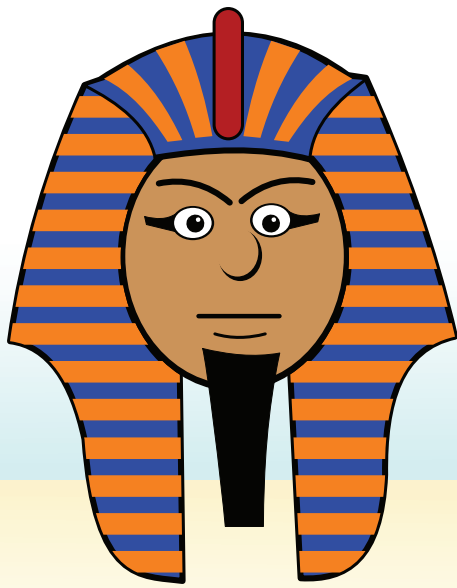
