## How to be Saved - Object Lesson on Salvation

- Good for any age •

**Main Point:** "Being a good person" is not the ticket to heaven. We need the Savior, Jesus.

**The Object Lesson:** Black Ink or Gold Ink

Materials needed: a large, thick book—the bigger the better. Watch the video (linked below) to see how to present the lesson.

### **Suggested Bible Passages:**

John 6:28,29

Then they asked Jesus, "What must we do to do the works God requires?"  
Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one He has sent."

Acts 16:30-31

The jailer asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"  
They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."

Luke 23:42-43

Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."  
Jesus answered him, "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in paradise."

- Show a large book as you begin the object lesson. See the video demonstration for details.
- Read and discuss your choice of Bible passages.
- Finish with the Class Activity game.

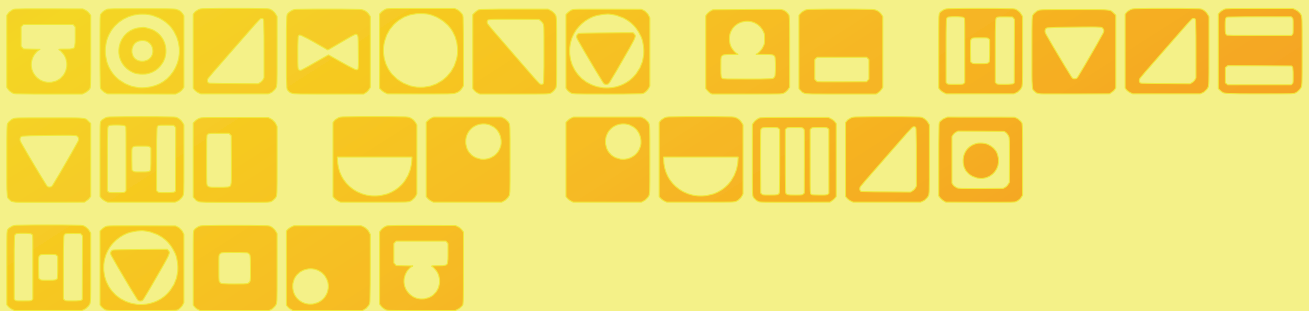

**Class Activity:** Bible Wars (recommended for Upper Elementary and above).

# BIBLE WARS!



**Simple to play.** Two teams vie to look up Bible references as you call them out. First player to find a reference stands up and reads it aloud. The player's team scores one point.

To help kids who haven't yet developed Bible skills, you might try this rule: Do not allow a player to answer twice in a row. A skilled player who is out for a turn can help an unskilled player look up the reference.

We've provided three rounds so losing teams get a second and third chance. Play as time permits.

**These Bible passages** mention the words *rescue*, *rescued* and *rescues* (as found in the NIV version). Acts 4:12 is here too, mentioning *saved* and *salvation*.
