Show Us the Father

- Best for Upper Elementary to High School •

Main Point: When we look at Jesus, we see God.

Suggested Bible Passages:

- The Son is the image of the invisible God. Colossians 1:15.
- The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of His being. Hebrews 1:3.
- Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father and that will be enough for us. Jesus answered: "Don't you know me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father." John 14:8,9.
- In 2 Corinthians 4:4, Paul calls Jesus "the image of God."

Instructions: Show the flashcards one at a time, starting with number 1 (McDonald's). Have your group try to identify what corporations or products the logos represent. You could assemble two teams that take turns. Answers are below.

When finished with the flashcards, discuss the Bible passages above. Make it clear that Jesus came to earth to reveal the true nature of God to us. When we choose to follow Christ, we are giving our lives over to Almighty God!

Activity Page: The flashcards serve as the printable activity that normally accompanies our lesson plans. However, here are a couple of things you might try:


- Have kids choose one word they would like to have as their personal logo (artwork optional). For example, "Christian" would be an excellent choice. To stimulate thinking, have kids choose one or two-word logos that reveal what godly trait they would most like to possess. This activity is probably best for High School ages.
- For younger kids, bring in a few magazines that small group's can pour over, looking for logos. Talk about what they find. You might point out that most logo images may be nice designs, but they don't accurately represent what a company actually does. For example, Apple Computers isn't in the grocery business. And the logo for Domino's Pizza has nothing to do with food. We could never guess what the Starbuck's logo is supposed to represent, certainly not coffee. But when it comes to Jesus, He is, in human form, the perfect representation of what God is like. Jesus reveals God's love, His power and much more.






