## How to Find God's Will

• Best for High School •

**Who This is For:** Mature kids interested in finding God's will.

**Main Point:** The most important way to study the Bible on this or any topic.

**Objects Required:** A 90-degree triangle (a page cut in the shape of a triangle will do, or even one drawn on a poster or chalkboard).

### 1. Present the Object Lesson

The Demonstration Video linked below shows how. In short, you'll use a triangle (representing a pyramid) to show the wisdom of understanding a verse in the light of many verses.

**2. Suggested Scripture:** 2 Timothy 2:15 - "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."

If you have kids in your group who intend to follow and serve Christ throughout life, 2 Timothy 2:15 is a great verse for them to memorize and act upon. And a great thing you can do for your group is to teach them how to "correctly handle the word of truth." For this lesson, you'll teach your kids one basic but absolutely essential Bible study method. Using the method, your kids will study what the Bible says about finding God's will. The Activity Page explains it all.

### 3. Activity Page: Triangulate the Truth!

To drive home the point that it is very important to use more than one Bible verse to understand a topic or truth covered by many Bible verses, the kids look up six verses that mention the will of God. By learning what each verse teaches, the kids end up with a more complete understanding of God's will for them. Kids can work on the page individually or as an entire class. Either way, be sure to discuss what the kids have discovered about God's will as well as how this activity fits in with the object lesson and the Bible story.
