The Name of Jesus • Good for kids eight and up •

Main Point: The various names and titles of Jesus found in the Bible make it crystal clear that Jesus is the name above all names. He is worthy of all honor and worship!

Objects Required: A tablet or phone with a capable wifi connection.

Preparation: Print two copies of the Name Game pages per small group of no more than four players each. The size of the cards allows them to be taped to the face of regular playing cards, to avoid kids being able to read through the thin paper when face down. Or print on cardstock.

Presentation Outline:

- Perform the Object Lesson.
- Optionally, choose one or more of the descriptions of Christ (found on the “sticky notes” page) to discuss as you see fit.
- Read the Philippians passage.
- Play the Name Game described in the Activity Pages section below.

The Object Lesson: Ask your group to tell you the meanings of their names. To search online for the meanings of names, simply type in “meaning of” followed by the desired name—that seems to work pretty well. Have fun, then transition to Philippians 2:9-11 by saying something like this: “Great names! Hey, in the Bible there are many names and titles for Jesus, and each one tells us something more about Him. For example...” (At this point read some or all of the 24 titles for Jesus on the “sticky notes” page, then read and discuss the Philippians passage).

Bible Passage: Philippians 2:9-11 - The Name of Jesus.

“God exalted Jesus to the highest place of all. God gave Him the name that is above every name. At the name of Jesus every knee will bow in heaven, on earth, even under the earth, and every tongue clearly admit that Jesus Christ is Lord! God will be glorified.” The passage makes it crystal clear that there is one name above all others: the name of Jesus.

Activity Pages: The Name Game is our tongue-in-cheek version of Concentration (also known as Memory). Players take turns turning two cards face up hoping to find a matching pair. In this game a matching pair will have a word or phrase that supposedly describes the player: good things like *smart, kind, good looking*. And a few not so good like *goofy, clumsy* and *smelly!* The players keep the cards they match; at the end of the game they read their names to the rest of the class. Be sure they understand this is supposed to be silly! BTW, the fewer players per game, the greater chance all players will find at least one matching pair.
