The Not a Crossword game is best for Upper Elementary and above.

Main Point: God will give us new bodies!

Though the object lesson is about our bodies that die due to sin, let's bounce off that to focus on the wonderful new ones we gain in Heaven.

Do the object lesson first, then discuss the suggested Bible passages.

Object Lesson: The Body of Death

Materials Needed: Scary or weird mask, long-sleeved hoodie—see the video for details.

Bible passages:

Romans 7:24, 25 - What we are like now. What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!

Matthew 17:1,2 - What Jesus is like now. Jesus took with Him Peter, James and John and led them up a high mountain by themselves. There His appearance was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light.

1 John 3:2 - We will be like Jesus. Dear friends, now we are God's children. What we will look like isn't yet known. But we know that when Christ appears we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

Philippians 3:20,21 - Jesus will change us. Our citizenship is in heaven, and we wait eagerly for our Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ. He has the power to bring everything under His control, by which He will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like His glorious body.

1 Corinthians 15:51-53 - We will live forever. Listen, I'm revealing a mystery: We will not all sleep the sleep of death, but we will all be changed—in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the very end when the last trumpet sounds. The trumpet will sound from heaven, the dead will be raised never to die again, and we will be changed. Our old body that dies will become imperishable!
